1. Vision, Mission and Function

2. Total Provision and Expenditure

The total net allocation made to the University Grants Commission was Rs. 72,711,106,000 and only Rs. 71,226,857,790 had been utilized by the end of the year under review. Accordingly, out of the net allocation, 1,484,248,210 or 2.04 percent remained. The details are given below.
